By this application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner, namely, Md. Sadek Ali has prayed for pre-arrest bail in connection with Tamulpur P.S. Case No. 148/2015 under Sections 489(B)/489(C) IPC.

The allegation made against the petitioner is that an amount of Rs. 80,000/- fak e Indian Currency note were found in possession of the petitioner after search ing his house on 25.07.2015.

Having hearing the learned counsel appearing for both the parties and considerin g the evidence so far collected by the I.O. as well as nature of alleged offence , I do not find it fit to extend the benefit of pre-arrest bail to the petition er.

Hence, the prayer for pre-arrest bail is rejected. The bail application is disposed of.
