Heard Mr. P.K. Talukdar, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. H. Sarma, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor, Assam, appearing for the State respondent.

Perused the case dairy.

By this application, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners, namely Sri Ranju Biswas, Sri Jitendra Barman and Sri Raju Barman have prayed for pre-arrest bail in connection with Pragjyotishpur P.S. Case No. 24/ 2015 (G.R. Case No. 804/2015) under Sections under Section 147/ 294/ 326/ IPC.

The allegations made against the petitioners are that, while the informant and others were enjoying a picnic party, the petitioners alongwith others, on 26.1.2015 assaulted them and others, causing injury to their persons.

Having heard the learned counsel for both the parties and considering the evidence so far collected by the I.O. as well the injury report, I find no reason for custodial interrogation of the petitioners. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioners in connection with the aforementioned case, the arresting authority shall release them on bail of Rs. 10,000/- each with one surety each of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.

Return the case dairy.

The bail application is disposed of.
