Heard Mr. A. Dhar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. B.B. Gogoi, learned Addl. P.P., Assam, appearing for the respondent State.

Perused the C.D.

By this application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner, namely, Sri Dayaram Yein, who was an employee of ONGC, has prayed for pre-arrest bail in connection with Jorhat P.S. Case No. 558/2015 under Section 468 IPC.

The allegation made against the petitioner is that the petitioner along with oth ers were found to be involved in committing forgery by using fabricated and bog us documents in respect of the tender papers relating to allotment of civil work at Jorhat under the ONGC during the year 2010.

Having heard the learned counsel appearing for both the parties and considering the evidence so far collected by the I.O., as well as the nature of alleged offe nce, I do not find it to be a fit case to grant the privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

In view of above, the prayer for pre-arrest bail is rejected. The bail application is disposed of. Return the C.D.
