By filing this application, the applicant/petitioner in AB No. 1634/2015 has prayed for correction of typographical mistake in the order dated 22.05.2015 passed by the Hon'ble Mr. Justice L.S.Jamir in AB No. 1634/2015.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Krishnai PS Case No. 83/2015 under Section 493/108/506/34 IPC filed the petitioner under Section 438 Cr. P.C. and they were allowed interim bail vide order dated 22.05.2014 passed in AB No. 1634/2015. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that they had applied for pre-arrest bail in Krishnai PS Case No. 83/2015 but inadvertently the order shows that they were allowed interim bail in connection with Krishnai PS Case No. 86/2015 under Section 447/448/294/506/34 IPC.

I have perused the original application under Section 438 Cr. P.C. moved in AB No. 1634/2015. In the cause title, both the cases i.e. Krishnai PS Case No. 83/2015 under Section 493/108/506/34 IPC and also Krishnai PS Case No. 86/2015 under Section 447/448/294/506/34 IPC have been mentioned.

However, from the prayer portion of the application it appears that the petitioners were apprehending their arrest in connection with Krishnai PS Case No. 83/2015 under Section 493/108/506/34 IPC and the said Krishnai PS Case No. 86/2015 is a cross case lodged by one of the petitioner. The petitioners had not applied for pre-arrest bail in connection with Krishnai PS Case No. 86/2015 nor they are stated to be accused in connection with aforesaid case. Therefore, the second paragraph of the order should be read as under:

The petitioners namely, (1) Nobo Paul @ Naba Kumar Paul (2) Khukon Paul @ Khukon Chandra Paul (3) Goda Paul have filed this application under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Krishnai PS Case No. 83/2015 under Section 493/108/505/34 IPC

With this correction, this I.A stands disposed of.
