Heard Mr. P. Deka, learned counsel representing the petitioner as well as Mr. P. S. Deka, learned counsel representing the State Respondents.

Considering the limited prayer made and as agreed to by the parties, this writ petition is taken-up for final disposal.

The petitioner contends that requisition compensation is payable to him by the State Respondents on account of the fact that her Tata Sumo vehicle bearing registration No. AS-01-Z-1931 had been requisitioned on various days covering the period from January, 2013 to September, 2014. According to the petitioner the amount of requisition compensation payable stands at Rs. 5,93,772.00. On account of the delay in making payment, the petitioner had also represented before the Senior Superintendent of Police, City, Guwahati in the required format. Although all information with regard to requisition of the vehicle had been brought to the notice of the respondent authorities, the petitioner contends that until this date, no action has been taken towards payment of the requisition compensation.

In view of the limited prayer made, this writ petition stands disposed of with a direction to the State Respondents to examine the case of the petitioner with regard to payment of requisition compensation and upon such examination/verification if the petitioner is found entitled to the amount so claimed and/or in part thereof, the same shall be disbursed/paid to her as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 2 (two) months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. The petitioner is permitted to produce a copy of this Order before the respondent authorities for their doing the needful.

Resultantly, this writ petition stands disposed of.
