Heard Mr. M.Khan, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. P. Saikia, learned Standing Counsel, Secondary Education appearing for respondent Nos. 1,3 & 5 and Ms. H. M. Phukan, learned Govt. Advocate appearing for respondent Nos. 2 & 4.

The father of the petitioner Md Mokhilisur Rahman Laskar , a Grade IV em ployee of Idgah Ashatul Islam Senior Madrassa of Karimganj district died in h arness on 02.03.2000. The petitioner being eligible, applied for his compassiona te appointment under die-in-harness scheme in Grade-IV post. The DLC, Karimganj in its meeting dated 23.12.2014 recommended the name of the petitioner for his a ppointment in Grade-IV post under the die-in-harness scheme. The grievance of the petitioner is that till date the SLC for such compassionate appointment have n ot taken any decision with regard to such compassionate appointment of the petitioner in spite of the recommendation of the DLC 23.12.2014.

After hearing the parties this writ petition is disposed directing the respondent No.1 namely, Commissioner & Secretary, Govt. of Assam, Secondary E ducation Department being the Principal Secretary of the SLC to place the case of the petitioner before the next meeting of the SLC, if not placed earlier, for his compassionate appointment as recommended by the DLC, Karimganj on 23.12.201 4. The SLC shall consider the case of the petitioner in terms of the decision of this Court in the case of Achyut Ranjan Das & ors.-Vs.-State of Assam & Ors, re ported in 2006 (4) GLT 674 and Fazirun Nessa & ors. Vs.State of Assam & ors re ported in 2010 (4) GLT 340 and Ajit Pator-Vs State of Assam & others reported in 2009(3) GLT 306 and SLC shall communicate the outcome of its decision to the p etitioner and shall carried out the entire exercise within a period of three mon ths from the date of production of certified copy of this order by the petitioner before Respondent No.1, Commissioner & Secretary, Secondary Education Department, Assam.

With the above observation, this petition stands disposed of.
