Heard Mr. MA Ahmed, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. RM Deka, the learned standing counsel, Education (Elementary) Department, Mr. S. Sarma, the learned standing counsel, SSA and Mr. MR Khandarkar, the learned counsel for the respondent No.6.

On careful perusal of the writ petition, I am of the view that the petitioner is essentially aggrieved by the order dated 8.5.2015 passed by this Court in WP(C) No. 2632/2015 and, as such, the remedy lies in a third party appeal by seeking p ermission of the Court. Confronted with this, the learned counsel for the petiti oner prays that he may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition with a liberty to file an appeal/review. The prayer is allowed.

The writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
