Heard the appellant and the respondent.

The orders of the Recovery Officer are to be challenged before the Debts Recovery Tribunal. In that view the appellant's approaching this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India and also filing this appeal will not be tenable. Appellant has to work out remedies only before the Debts Recovery Tribunal. In that view of the matter the appellant is given liberty to approach the Debts Recovery Tribunal. The Debts Recovery Tribunal shall dispose of the matter without being influenced by any order of this Court or by the learned Single Judge. The order of status quo granted shall continue for about fifteen days. In the meantime the appellant can approach the Tribunal and take appropriate orders. Accordingly the misc case is disposed of.
