It reveals from the F.I.R. that the informant developed intimacy with the petitioner and they established physical relation. The sexual relation between the informant and the petitioner was prevailing from the year 2010 until 2013. When the petitioner refused to marry, this case has been lodged.

It is submitted that parties have settled their disputes and filed a joint compromise petition before the lower court. In paragraph-5, it is written that there was consensual relation between the parties and whatever have taken place that was with consent and not with coercion or fraudulent inducement.

Counsel for the State has opposed the prayer.

Since the parties have settled the disputed and petitioner has already remained in custody for four months, he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of Additional Judicial Commissioner – III – cum – F.T.C. Ranchi in connection with S.T. No. 18 of 2015.
