The petitioner is an accused in a case registered under Sections 323, 341, 379 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that the petitioner has taken loan to the extent of Rs.2.50 lacs. The loan taken was not refunded, rather the petitioner caused assault to the informant and snatched away wrist watch and other articles from his possession.

It is submitted that it is a case of false allegation. No such incident ever took place. So far as the loan is concerned, the complainant shall be at liberty to recover the same through process of court.

Counsel for the State has opposed the petitioner's prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to surrender before the court below within two weeks from today and, if he does so, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount, each, to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Bokaro in connection with C.P. Case No.347 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
