Heard Mr. Anjani Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Kaushik Sarkhel, learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner has been made an accused in connection with Manoharpur P.S. Case No. 09 of 2013 registered under Sections 302/201/120-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that there was no direct allegation levelled against the petitioner. It has further been submitted that petitioner is in custody since 2.2.2013.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that six witnesses have already been examined and two witnesses are still left to be examined.

In the impugned order, it appears that petitioner was one of the persons who had taken away the deceased and subsequently the deceased did not return and dead body was found.

Regard being had to the direct nature of allegation, I am not inclined to grant bail.

Hence, his prayer for bail is hereby rejected.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 02.02.2013, the trial court is directed to examine the rest of the witnesses and conclude the trial within a period of three months from the date of receipt/production of a copy this order.
