06/31.10.2015 Anticipatory bail application filed by Mohammad Ismail, is moved by Sri. Nikhilesh Kumar Chatterjee, learned counsel for the petitioner and opposed by Sri P.K. Appu, learned Additional P.P for the State.

It appears that the dispute between the parties is with respect to private loan and it is alleged that the petitioner is not returning the said loan. Thus, *prima facie*, it appears that the dispute between the parties is civil in nature.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I allow the anticipatory bail application and direct petitioner to surrender in the court below on or before 14.11.2015 and in the event of his surrender, the learned court below is directed to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Hazaribag, in connection with Complaint Case No. 795 of 2011, subject to the condition as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
