**04/ 30.01.2015** The petitioner is an accused in a case registered under Sections 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code r/w Section 3/4 of the D.P. Act.

The petitioner has been prosecuted for causing torture and treating the complainant with cruelty for want of more dowry demanded in terms of Freeze, T.V. etc.

It is submitted that the petitioner is rotting in jail custody for more than six months. The allegation of demand of dowry and torture is of general in nature.

Counsel for the State as well informant have opposed the prayer and submitted that Annexure-2 is fake document, ante dated and it has been filed to mislead the Court. The informant has been subjected to torture on various occasion by various means.

So far Annexure-2 is concerned, if the informant thinks it to be a forged document, she shall be at liberty to take appropriate action.

Considering matrimonial nature of the offence, period of detention of the petitioner in jail custody, he is hereby directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- ( Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Rajiv Ranjan, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Ranchi in connection with Chutia P.S. Case No. 129/2014, corresponding to G.R.No. 3637/2014.
