02/ 30.01.2015 The petitioner is an accused in a case registered under Sections 144/341/323/342/506/387/307/379 of the Indian Penal Code in connection with B.S. City P.S. Case No. 169/2014, corresponding to G.R.No.740/2014, pending in the Court of the C.J.M., Bokaro.

There is allegation in the F.I.R. that accused persons intercepted the informant, overpowered him and caused assault. Belongings of the informant like cash, A.T.M. card, golden chain have been snatched away. The informant was further compelled to sign certain paper and directed to put his L.T.I. too.

It is submitted that nothing incriminating has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. Save and except he has asked the informant to put his L.T.I. on certain paper, no further overt act is alleged against him. He is in custody since 05.11.2014.

Counsel for the State has opposed the prayer.

It appears from the F.I.R. that the petitioner with his associates, not only assaulted the informant but also snatched away his belongings.

Considering the allegation, I do not feel inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, prayer for bail made on his behalf stands rejected.
