The petitioner has been made an accused for the offence registered under Sections 366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 10/13 of POSCO Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. He further pointing out the statement of the victim girl recorded under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. submitted that there does not appear any allegation against the petitioner and the victim girl has herself stated that her signature was obtained on a blank paper and she has not filed this case. Learned counsel further submitted that the other co-accused Ashique Ansari has been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 13.04.2015 passed in B.A. No. 698 of 2015 and since the case of this petitioner stands on similar footing, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

Learned A.P.P opposed the prayer for bail but fairly submitted that other co-accused has been released on bail by this Court.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, the statement of victim girl recorded under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. and the fact that the other co-accused has been released on bail by this Court, I am inclined to release this petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the petitioner above named is directed to be enlarged on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Fahim Kirmani, learned Judicial Magistrate, Ranchi in connection Nagari P.S. Case no. 132 of 2014, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 5868 of 2014.
