It reveals from the fardbayan that Sabita Devi, sister of the informant was found missing from the matrimonial home since 27.08.2014. The dead body of Sabita Devi was found on 29.08.2014 lying in a well of Basudeo Yadav.

It is submitted that the informant has named the petitioner and other accused persons in the F.I.R. disclosing allegations that they were causing assault to the deceased and they have killed Sabita Devi and threw the dead body in a well. No eye witness has come forward to support the prosecution case. According to the postmortem report, no external or internal injury was found at the time of postmortem examination and cause of death has been opined as asphyxia due to drawing. The petitioner is not related to the deceased.

Counsel for the State as well as the informant have opposed the prayer.

Considering facts and circumstances as well as evidence collected in the case diary, the petitioner named above is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of J.M., Giridih in connection with Gawan P.S. Case No. 101/2014 [G.R. No. 2658/2014].
