Anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioners Foolchand Rajak and Ambika Devi in connection with Bishnugarh P.S. Case No. 122 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No. 4955 of 2014 for the offence registered under Sections 341/323/379/354 of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the State and perused the documents available on record.

Counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submits that both the petitioners are old aged persons and are husband and wife. It has further been stated that due to land dispute they have been implicated in this case.

Learned A.P.P. opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, Foolchand Rajak and Ambika Devi. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of surrender/arrest, the petitioners named above, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Hazaribagh, in connection with Bishnugarh P.S. Case No. 122 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No. 4955 of 2014, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
