The petitioner has been made accused for the offence under Sections 304-B / 34 of the Indian Penal Code, in connection with S.T. No. 251 of 2014, arising out of Hariharpur P.S. Case No. 11 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No. 1094 of 2014.

The case relates to dowry death and the petitioner is the husband of the deceased.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the informant and his family members have been examined in this case, but they have turned hostile. The depositions of the witnesses have been brought on record.

In the facts of this case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, Santosh Thakur @ Santosh @ Narayan Thakur, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII, Dhanbad, in connection with S.T. No. 251 of 2014, arising out of Hariharpur P.S. Case No. 11 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No. 1094 of 2014.
