Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Addl. Government Advocate.

This application has been filed by the petitioners challenging the inaction of the opposite party No.3 in not registering the F.I.R dated 07.07.2015.

Pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 21.9.2015 opposite party No.2-Superintendent of Police, Khurda has appeared before this Court in person and furnished a report, which reveals that the F.I.R was registered as Banpur P.S. Case No.195 of 2015 under Sections 342/385/506/307/34 I.P.C. It was also stated to provide necessary protection to the informant and his family members.

In view of the above, this Court disposes of this CRLMP with a direction to opposite party No.2-Superintendent of Police, Khurda that on completion of the investigation, consequential steps shall be taken and necessary protection be provided to the petitioners and their family members as and when necessary. The personal appearance of the opposite party No.2-Superintendent of Police, Khurda is dispensed with accordingly.
