

3. 30.4.2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Addl. Government Advocate.

2. This Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioners to direct the opposite parties to extend the undisputed land acquisition compensation amount in their favour as per the award dated 04.2.2011 passed by the Special Land Acquisition Officer (MIP), Jagatsinghpur in L.A Misc. Case No.356 of 2008 (L.A No.3 of 2006) under Sections 9, 11 and 12 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 within a stipulated period.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that though the petitioners have filed a representation before the Collector, Jagatsinghpur – opposite party no.1 on 11.12.2014 under Annexure-6 highlighting their grievance, no action has been taken as yet.

4. Considering the above, without going into the merits of the case, this Court disposes of this Writ Petition with a direction to the Collector, Jagatsinghpur – opposite party no.1 to dispose of the representation filed by the petitioners under Annexure-6 in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order along with a copy of this Writ Petition.
