Heard Mr. Biswal, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. B.K. Dash, learned counsel on behalf of opposite party Nos.5 & 6.

The allegation of the petitioner is that the students, who studied in the petitioners institution, namely, Bhanjabhumi Industrial Training Centre (ITC) have been directed to appear at Shreekheta ITC at Udala. Although, the Admit Cards have been issued to the students of the petitioners institution, it is asserted that Shreekheta ITC at Udala is no longer functioning.

On learning of the aforesaid facts, it is stated on behalf of the petitioner that the Principal/Secretary of the petitioners institution approaches the authorities concerned and they were orally informed that the examination would be conducted at another place, namely, Shyamsundarpur but, the petitioner apprehends that, even if, the students go to Shyamsundarpur which is at a distance of 60 Kms., the question papers sent to Udala may not be re-assigned to Shyamsundarpur and the Invigilators, who may have been designated to oversee the examination at Udala, may not be re-assigned to Shyamsundarpur and consequently, the same may cause the students of the petitioners institution not to be able to appear in the examination.

In view of the facts as averred in paragraph-7 of the writ application, we direct the petitioner to appear before the Vice-Chairman, State Council for Technical Education and Vocational Training along with a certified copy of this order and, thereafter, the Vice-Chairman shall take necessary steps as he may deem appropriate in the circumstances in order to protect the interest of the students.

With the aforesaid observations and directions, this writ application is disposed of.

A free copy of this order be handed over to Mr. B.K. Dash, learned counsel for opposite party Nos.5 & 6 in course of the day for necessary communication and compliance.

Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application in course of the day.
