## **Order On Board**

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though on the report of the petitioner, FIR has been registered by the police, further proceedings towards seizure and other steps for prevention of violation of copy right as required under Section 64 of the Copy Right Act are not being taken by the police authorities.
