The petitioner through the instant petition challenges the order dated 23.1.2015 (Annexure P-1) whereby the services of the petitioner have been transferred from Primary Health Center, Nagarnar, Distt. Bastar to Community Health Center, Geedam, Distt. Dantewada.

- 2. Without entering into merits of the case, this Court feels that ends of justice would meet if the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to make a representation to respondent No.1 against the impugned order to be made within a period of one week from today and on such representation being made, it is expected that the State Government shall take decision as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the representation.
- 3. With the above said observation, the instant Writ Petition stands disposed of.
