This is a petition moved under section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking extension of time to surrender and apply for regular bail before the trial court which was granted vide order of this court dated 19/11/2014 passed in Misc. Cri.C.No. 10534/14.

By the aforesaid order, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial court concerned on or before 28/11/2014 and on surrender he was directed to apply for regular bail. It is submitted by the counsel that due to compelling family circumstances, the applicant could not appear within the stipulated period fixed and apply for his regular bail before the trial court. Hence, by moving the present petition it is prayed that sometime may be given to obey the directions aforesaid.

Such prayer was opposed by the learned Panel Lawyer for the State.

After taking into consideration the arguments advanced and the reasons assigned in the petition, the prayer of the petitioner is allowed. The time uptil 5^{th} May

2015 is extended to the petitioner to surrender and apply for bail before the trial court in terms of earlier order.

It is made clear that if the order aforesaid is not complied with, the police authority will be free to arrest the petitioner after 5^{th} May 2015, if required in the present crime.

Subject to above directions, the petition stands disposed of finally.
