For the nature of relief claimed in the writ petition no indulgence is warranted under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, as petitioner has a remedy of filing an appeal under Section 17 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002, against the measures taken by the respondent/Bank under Section 13 (4) of the Act; the only remedy available under the Act of 2002, as the jurisdiction is also barred under Section 34 of the Act.

With the aforesaid observation, writ petition stands disposed of.
