

Ramgopal Sharma Vs. State of M.P. & Ors.

With the consent of parties, this petition is heard finally.

In this petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India, the petitioner has assailed the order dated 02/11/2015, by which, the petitioner who is posted as Head Master has been transferred from one School to another School in District Vidisha.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been transferred in the mid of academic sessions and in case the petitioner has been forced to implement the order of transfer then his entire family will be affected. It is submitted that petitioner has submitted a representation to District Education Officer, Dist. Vidisha / respondent No. 3 and the aforesaid authority may be directed to decide the same. It is further submitted that nobody has been posted in place of the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned Government

Advocate for the respondents submits that suitable action will be taken on the representation submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law.

In view of aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and in the facts of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Till the representation (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner is decided by the aforesaid authority, taking into account the fact that nobody has been posted in place of the petitioner, the petitioner shall be permitted to work at present place of posting.

With the aforesaid directions, this writ petition stands disposed of.
