The petitioner has filed the present writ petition challenging the order dated 1/8/2014 published in daily news paper â Dainik Bhashkarâ on 26/8/2014 thereby terminating the services of the petitioner Against the said order of termination, the petitioner has filed an appeal/representation to respondent No.3. He, therefore, prays that an appropriate directions may be issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the appeal/representation of the petitioner within a stipulated period of time.
