This is first bail application filed by the applicants-accused under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail in connection with Crime No17/2015 registered at Police Station Bhagwa, District Chhatarpur for offence under Section 307, 147, 148, 149, 294, 323, 332 and 506 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the applicants-accused submits that the applicants-accused have been falsely implicated in this case. Twenty persons by name and eight unnamed persons have been mentioned in the FIR. As per the allegations of the case diary, a connection dispute arose in with panchayat election. Rammilan, Jagdish, Rajendra Prasad and TI Sisodia, who were deputed for law and order duty, were assaulted by the persons of the mob. Counsel further pleads that no grievous or fatal injury was caused to any person by any one of the applicants. Investigation has been completed. Hence, the applicant-accused be granted bail.

Learned Panel Lawyer for the State opposing the submissions made on behalf of the applicants-accused has prayed for rejection of the bail application.

## M.Cr.C. No.6694/2015

On perusal of the case diary, it is evident that name of twenty persons and eight unnamed persons have been mentioned in the FIR. On perusal of the medical report of the injured persons, it transpires that neither grievous injury nor fatal injury to the police personnel who were deputed for law and order duty was caused to anyone of them. Investigation has been completed. Other co-accused were granted bail vide order dated 13.5.2015 passed in M.Cr.C. No.5556/2015.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this court deems it fit to grant bail to the applicants-accused. Hence, allowing this application, it is ordered that applicants be released on bail on their furnishing personal bonds for the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) each with separate sureties for the like amount to the satisfaction of the Committal Court/trial Court for securing their presence before the said Court on all the dates of hearing fixed in this regard during trial. Provisions of Section 437 (3) of Cr.P.C. shall apply to the applicants.

M.Cr.C. stands disposed of.
