This is the first bail application under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. The applicant is apprehending arrest for offence punishable under Sections 294, 323, 326, 506 and 34 of the IPC in connection with Crime No.178/15 registered at Police Station Bhedaghat, District Jabalpur.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the applicant seeks withdrawal of the anticipatory bail application with a direction to surrender the applicant before the trial Court and the Court may be directed to consider the bail application on the same date.

Prayer for surrender has not been opposed by the other side.

Considering the aforesaid, the bail application stands dismissed as withdrawn with a direction to the applicant to surrender before the trial Court and apply for regular bail, which shall be decided as expeditiously as possible.
