Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was retired from the post of Ranger vide order dated 31.5.2011 State Government has issued circular dated 29.6.2015 by which it has been directed that the employee shall be entitled to get retiral dues within a stipulated period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent having extended the benefit of leave encashment to the petitioner, the petitioner, therefore, submit a representation Annexure P/3 and P/4 to the respondents, he therefore, prays that an appropriate direction may be issued to the respondents to consider and decide the representations Annexure P/3 and P/4.

Learned counsel for the respondents does not opposes the said prayer.

In view of this, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/3 and P/4 by speaking order within a period of three months' from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order passed today.
