1. None for the petitioner. The counsel for the  
respondents are present. Prayer clause (a) of the petition reads  
thus :

“(a) This Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a  
Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ,  
direction or order directing the respondents to  
cancel the said Vehicle Under Pass (VUP) at the  
Chanage No. 5 (Shirdhon pada-Chinchwan) nearly 1  
km. North Side on Panvel-Goa Highway from  
Shirdhon village, Taluka Panvel, District Raigad and  
instead that to give the Highway Median cut on the  
ground at the said km. Chanage no. 5 at N.H. 17,  
village Shirdhon.”

2. In the writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the

Constitution of India, Writ Court cannot decide in what manner the Authorities should construct the Vehicle Under Pass (VUP) on Goa National Highway. It is for the Experts appointed by the competent authority to decide the said issue. Hence, no interference is called for under the writ jurisdiction. Petition is rejected.
