Heard Mr. A.I. Sheikh, learned counsel for the Applicant and Mr. S.S. Doifode, learned APP for the respondent-State.

Against the applicant, a report is lodged by Smt. Jahera Khan Firoz Khan, who is the mother of the prosecutrix. The age of the prosecutrix is just six years. The present applicant, to whom the prosecutrix used to call "Mamu", i.e., maternal uncle, on the day of the incident, called her inside his house and after offering her "Kurkure", he removed her clothes and meddled with her private parts.

The offence is serious looking to the nature of the acts done by the present applicant with a girl of six years. Hence no case is made out for exercising discretion. Application is rejected.
