THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 AND 227 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA PRAYING TO DIRECT THE R-2 TO CONSIDER THE REPRESENTATION GIVEN BY THE PETITIONER DT.13.1.2015 VIDE ANNEXURE-B TO THIS W.P.

THIS WRIT PETITION COMING ON FOR PRELIMINARY HEARING, THIS DAY, THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING:

**ORDER**

The learned Government Advocate to accept notice for respondent No.1. Sri H.M.Manjunath, learned counsel accepts notice for respondent No.2. They are permitted to file their memo of appearance/Vakalath in four weeks.

2. The petitioner is before this Court seeking for issue of mandamus to direct the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to consider the representation dated 13.01.2015. The petitioner claims to be a permanent resident of Arasikere and in that regard she is seeking allotment from the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to possess a house. A Circular at Annexure-A is relied on by the petitioner and in that light representation at Annexure-B has been made. The details need not be adverted to, since allotment of sites

by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent would have to be made in terms of the Karnataka Housing Board (Allotment) Regulations, 1983. In view of the same, a direction is necessary to be issued in this petition to consider in terms thereof.

3. Hence, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent shall take note of the representation submitted by the petitioner in terms of the allotment Regulation and pass orders accordingly. To enable the consideration, the petitioner shall file one more copy of the representation along with the supporting documents along with a certified copy of this order. The 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent shall consider the same and intimate the result of the consideration to the petitioner within the outer limit of two months from the date of which it is submitted.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
