Heard. The applicant/appellant has moved this application for discharge of her guardian on the ground that she has attained majority. In support of such averment, the copy of birth certificate has been appended as Annexure A-1 with the application, which clearly indicates that the applicant was born on 15.3.1996 and has now attained majority. The application is allowed and the guardian of the applicant is discharged and the applicant is permitted to pursue the lis in her own capacity. Application stands disposed of.

However, taking into consideration the fact that the appeal stands finally decided by this Court on 18.12.2015 and there is nothing on record to show that any further appeal has been filed, let the entire compensation amount alongwith upto date interest be released in favour of the applicant/respondent No.1 by remitting the same to her bank account as detailed in para-6 of the application. Application stands disposed of.
