### **ORDER**

3.The petitioner has made a representation to the respondents dated 16.03.2015 seeking to remove the encroachment made by the fourth respondent in Survey No.268/13 and 268/20 R.S.Mangalam Village, Thiruvadanai Taluk, Ramanathapuram District.



4.Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that it would suffice if the representation of the petitioner, dated 16.03.2015, is directed to be disposed of by the first respondent within a stipulated time.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion as to the merits of the contentions raised by the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of directing the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 16.03.2015 on merits and in accordance with law, and pass appropriate orders, after giving opportunity to the petitioner, the fourth respondent as well as the interested parties if any, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
