## THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAMALINGESWARA RAO

## WRIT PETITION No.15054 of 2014

## **ORDER:**

Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Pleader for respondent Nos.1 to 4.

This Writ Petition is filed challenging the action of the second respondent in issuing Certificate of Provisional Registration of Freshwater Aquaculture Farm dated 16.03.2013 in favour of respondent Nos.5 and 6 without following the guidelines issued in G.O.Ms.No.7, dated 16.03.2013.

This Court, by order dated 05.06.2014, while admitting the Writ Petition directed respondent Nos.1 and 2 to consider the objections raised by the petitioners before granting any final registration to respondent Nos.5 and 6. It was also directed that respondent Nos.1 to 4 should ensure that respondent Nos.5 and 6 do not violate the terms and conditions of G.O.Ms.No.7, dated 16.03.2013.

Now the learned Counsel for the petitioners filed W.P.M.P.No.45918 of 2014, which contains a copy of the letter addressed by the fifth respondent to the District Collector stating that he was not interested in converting his land as a fish pond and he wanted to raise trees on the bunds constructed by him.

Be that as it may, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that it is not clear whether respondent No.5 converts his land for pisi-culture or uses his bunds for raising trees.

In the circumstances, the Writ Petition is disposed of in terms of the interim order dated 05.06.2014, as indicated above. The miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
