ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for the following substantive relief:

*“...to issue a writ or order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents in interfering with the activities in setting up fresh water aquaculture ponds in survey No.410/2, 410/3, 411/1,3, to an extent of 8 acres 45 cents situated at Padamara vipparu Village, Pentapadu Mandal, West Godavari District, without passing the orders on the application, dated 31.3.2010 as bad, illegal,*

*contrary to G.O.Ms.No.18, Animal Husbandry Dairy Development and Fisheries (F.II) Department, Dated 26.3.2008 and violative of Article 14 and 21 of Constitution of India.”*

At the hearing, Mr. Rudresh Deshpande, learned counsel representing Mr. G. Tuhin Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner, submitted that the cause in the writ petition does not survive for adjudication. In view of the same, the writ petition is dismissed as infructuous.

As a sequel to dismissal of the writ petition, interim order dt.9.6.2011 in W.P.M.P.No.17772 of 2011 shall stand vacated, and W.P.M.P. No.17772 of 2011 and W.V.M.P. No.1180 of 2012 shall stand disposed of as infructuous.
