AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record an extract of her Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 25.06.1996 and petitioner No.2 has placed on record an extract of his Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his year of birth as 1989. They have also moved a representation before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
