AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.3 to 10.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has not placed on record any document but has filed an affidavit(Annexure P-2) wherein she has deposed that as per school records her date of birth is 16.10.1994 and petitioner No.2 has placed on record photocopy of his Matriculation Examination Certificate(Annexure P-1) depicting his date of birth as 23.02.1993. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-7) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without advertig to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-7).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
