Petitioner has approached this Court seeking the following relief:

“(i) To issue a suitable writ, order or direction or a writ in the nature of mandamus thereby commanding the respondents to give promotion to the petitioner as Principal Government Inter College in the light of the letter dated 13.4.2015 of the respondent no. 2 which is Annexure 5 to this writ petition.”

2. Very briefly put, the case of the petitioner is as follows:

Petitioner, who started his service as an Assistant Teacher, was ordered to be promoted by order dated 25.01.2012. His complaint is that he is not being given promotion as Principal, Government Inter College and, according to him, many a juniors have been promoted; those promotions he does not seek to challenge. He only says that he is going to retire in August, 2016 and the posts of Principal Government Inter College are lying vacant, where he can also be considered. Petitioner has already filed Annexure-8 representation before the first respondent.

3. After hearing the learned Deputy Advocate General also, we dispose of the writ petition by directing the first respondent to consider Annexure-8 representation of the petitioner and take a

decision on the same, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of production of a certified copy of this judgment.
