This matter arises out of Section 125 CrPC in which maintenance of Rs.1500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Only) per month was granted to the respondent no. 2/wife and Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) was granted to the child by the learned Judge, Family court, Pauri Garhwal vide order dated 06.08.2015. Aggrieved, the applicant (husband) has filed the present revision before this Court.
- 4. In view of this Court, the amount fixed above cannot be called excessive.
- 5. In view of the above, no interference is called for in the matter, the criminal revision is hereby dismissed in limine.
