By means of present writ petition, the petitioner seeks to issue a writ of certiorari to quash the impugned recovery citation dated 29.10.2015 passed by the respondent no.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is ready to repay the loan amount in easy installments. Learned counsel for the petitioner confined his prayer only to the extent that the respondent-bank be directed to decide the representation of the petitioner for repaying the loan in easy monthly installments.

The innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is allowed.

The writ petition is disposed of by directing that if the petitioner moves a representation for making easy installments of loan before the respondent-bank within a week from today, the respondent-bank shall consider the prayer of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of production of a certified copy of this order alongwith a copy of the representation. The respondent-bank shall pass a formal order fixing the monthly installments.

The impugned recovery citation shall remain stayed till the representation of the petitioner is decided by the respondent-bank.
