Applicant Anuj alias Neetu seeks bail in connection with case crime no. 286 of 2014, under Sections 379, 411, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Kotwali Roorkee, District Haridwar.

Heard learned counsel for the parties, considered the grounds taken in the bail application and perused the documents on record.

An FIR was lodged against unknown thief on 15.08.2014, alleging therein that on the selfsame day, motorcycle of the informant was stolen away. Recovery memo dated 17.08.2014 indicates that one motorcycle each was recovered from the possession of the applicant and other accused persons, on which they were riding at the time of recovery. Applicant is not a previous convict and is in jail since 17.08.2014.

Co-accused Rohit Saini, with similar role, has been directed to be enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 24.12.2014. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is ready to furnish reliable sureties to the satisfaction of Magistrate concerned, if he is granted bail.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, a case for bail is made out in favour of present applicant on the basis of parity.

Bail application is allowed. Let the applicant be released on bail on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of like amount to the satisfaction of Magistrate concerned.
