## **HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE RAGHUVENDRA S. RATHORE**

Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the conviction and sentence awarded to the accused petitioner and the fact that he was on bail during trial as also in appeal and the hearing of the revision is not likely to take place in near future, I deem it just and proper to suspend the execution of sentence awarded to the petitioner, during the pendency of the revision petition.

Accordingly, the application for suspension of sentence is allowed and it is ordered that the sentence awarded to accused-petitioner Nand Lal S/o Shri Ram Chandra in Criminal Case No.605/2011 (655/2001) shall remain suspended; provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs. 1,00,000/- and two sureties bond of Rs. 50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court to the effect that he shall appear before this Court on 30.6.2015 and, as and when called upon to do so.
