BY THE COURT:-

The restoration application has been filed
with the contention that the matter was listed on
05/02/2015. The counsel was busy in another court
and when he rushed to the court, the matter was
disposed of hence, absence was bonafide and the
appeal be restored to its original number.

Heard learned counsel for the applicant-
appellants and perused the impugned-order.

Perusal of the impugned-order speaks that
none appeared on 05/02/2015 and also, requisite
notices have not been filed since 04/12/2009 hence,
appeal has not been dismissed only for the absence of

the counsel for the applicant-appellants but also for non-compliance of the order and it has also been brought to the notice of this Court that earlier also on 17/04/2012, appeal has been dismissed by peremptory order as requisite PF & Notices have not been filed. Advocate could be busy in another court but the appellant is the State and officer-in-charge was under a duty to be present in court to comply with the orders of this Court but the officer-in-charge has remained negligent and no reason has been shown why the officer-in-charge was not present on that day and why order of this Court has not been complied since 2009.

Hence, in view of above, there is no good and sufficient cause to restore the appeal.

Consequently, this restoration application is dismissed.
