In the instant contempt petition preferred under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, a grievance has been made by the petitioner that the order dated 19/12/2008 passed by the learned Single Judge in S.B. Civil Writ petition No.14144/2008 has not been complied with.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the petition has been filed for compliance of the interim order passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.14144/2008.

The learned counsel appearing for the respondents has submitted that the above said writ petition has been decided and, hence, interim order is no longer in vogue.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner has prayed that he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition with liberty to seek compliance of the order passed in the writ petition.

As prayed, the present contempt petition is, hereby, **dismissed** as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
