After taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case as well as nature of allegation against the petitioner which has also been taken up by the informant in the election petition filed before the District & Sessions Judge, Karauli u/s 43 of the Rajasthan Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant indulgence of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

The S.H.O./I.O./Arresting Authority, Police Station Balghat (Karauli) in F.I.R. No.29/2015 is directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner Harswaroop S/o Shri Gangaram, he shall be released on bail, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- each to his satisfaction on the following conditions :-

- (i). that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii). that the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer; and
- (iii). that the petitioner shall not leave India without previous permission of the court.
