Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record of the case.

It is stated that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. Initially a complaint was against Executive Officer of Municipal Council and even cashier. No material exists to implicate the petitioner other than recovery but that itself does not corroborate the allegations made against the petitioner. He may thus be granted bail.

Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application. He submits that investigation in the case has not yet been completed, thus petitioner may not be granted bail.

After considering rival submissions of the parties and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, which may otherwise affect outcome of the trial, but looking to the facts of this case, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, bail application is dismissed, however, with liberty to file a fresh bail application before the court below after filing of the charge sheet.
