Heard learned counsel for the petitioner,  
learned Public Prosecutor for the State and perused the  
relevant documents placed before me.

Contention of learned counsel for the petitioner  
is that alleged offence against the petitioner is u/s.457,  
380 & 120B IPC. There is only one previous case registered  
against him for the same offence. Co-accused Lalu @  
Lalchand, Sonu @ Sarfaraz @ Sharafat Khan & Gab Singh have  
already been released on bail by different coordinate  
benches of this Court. Trial may take long.

Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail  
application.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of  
this case but taking into consideration all the facts and  
circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge  
the petitioner on bail.

In the result, this bail application u/S.439  
Cr.P.C. is allowed and it is directed that petitioner  
Ganpat Lal S/o Champa Lal shall be released on bail in

F.I.R. No.104/2015, P.S. Dag, Distt. Jhalawar for offence u/s.457, 380 & 120B IPC to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.2,00,000/- together with two sureties in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- each to the satisfaction of the trial Court for his appearance before that court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so till conclusion of the trial.
