On consideration of submissions made on behalf of the respective parties and the material made available for my perusal as well as the evidence collected during investigation, which has been placed on record by way of copy of the charge-sheet in the connected file, and more particularly looking to the fact that the similarly situated co-accused have already been granted benefit of bail by this Court, but without expressing any final opinion on the merit and de-merit of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the accused-petitioner.

Consequently, the bail application filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is allowed.

It is ordered that the accused-petitioner Mukesh Kumar S/o Shri Jairoop chand in F.I.R. No.508/2014, registered at Police Station Nadbai, District Bharatpur, shall be released on bail; provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two surety bonds of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
